



PURPOSE:

- Assist detectives in developing new leads on unsolved murders and sexual assault cases.
- Collaboration with subject matter experts in DNA, forensic investigative genetic genealogy, pathology, and cold case investigations.

CASE PRESENTATIONS:

- Detectives will submit unsolved cases for consideration of presentation to the group.
- Approximately 12-15 Unsolved Cases will be selected to be presented by detectives in a formal, structured manner. Subject matter experts will provide real time feedback on these and other cases.

EXPERT PARTICIPATION:

- Subject matter experts will be present for the entire week, providing training and suggestions for further case development.
- Experts will offer actionable advice for follow-up investigation.

CASE SUPPORT:

• Course facilitators will provide a detailed list of suggestions for follow-up investigations to detectives presenting cases.

ACTIVE PARTICIPATION FOR ATTENDEES:

- Non-presenting detectives will actively engage in unsolved homicides and violent crime cases.
- Develop new tools and techniques to apply to their own caseloads.
- Subject matter experts will be available for case-specific questions and guidance.

ADDITIONAL EXPERTISE:

• Other forensic experts will be utilized as needed throughout the course.
