**Incident Summary:** Officers were dispatched to the area of I-270 N. and W. Broad St. on reports of gunshots fired. During the investigation officers made contact with the caller who stated while they were traveling on 270 N. around the W. Broad St. exit in a blue Chrysler 2002, a second vehicle described as a black car, pulled along side and that driver brandished a firearm. Gunshots were fired and the driver of the Chrysler drove to a near by gas station to meet police. At approximately 6:12 a.m. Officers were dispatched to a local hospital on a walk in gunshot victim who self transported in a black Mercedes. That victim told officers she was in the same area in her vehicle when she heard gunshots and realized she had been struck by gunfire. Police have all parties involved.
