Incident Summary:
 On August 13, 2024, at 8:11 PM, Columbus Police officers were dispatched to the 3500 block of Clime Rd. on a reported shooting. Upon arrival, the officers found one victim, identified as GAGE ANDERSON, age 17, unresponsive and suffering from a gunshot wound. Columbus Fire medics arrived and transported Anderson to a local hospital, where he was pronounced deceased at 8:40 PM. Next of kin notification has been made.

Witnesses described a vehicle leaving the scene and a police helicopter crew quickly located that vehicle in the area. After a vehicle was stopped near the intersection of Lynward Rd. and Maurine Dr., the driver, identified as SKYLER BURLEY, age 30, was taken into custody. Burley was charged with Murder and slated into the Franklin County Jail. The parties involved are unknown to one another and the motive stems from a "road-rage" incident.
