On September 5, 2023, the Columbus Police Organized Crime Bureau (OCB) responded to 227 N. Warren Ave. on a fatal overdose. It was discovered that a 13 year old child had overdosed on a combination of Cocaine and fentanyl.

First responding Patrol Officers observed packaged narcotics in plain view when entering the home. The home was secured and a search warrant obtained by Detectives. The search resulted in the seizure of approximately 8 Kilograms of narcotics, to include Fentanyl, Cocaine, Methamphetamine, and Crack Cocaine. Additionally, 2 firearms were recovered.

Narcotics Detectives with the Columbus Police, Organized Crime Bureau initiated an investigation as a result of the evidence seized.

Detectives utilized the Ohio Narcotics Intelligence Center, ONIC, to examine various electronic devices seized throughout the investigation. The information obtained proved to be of great value and lead to several more major drug seizures.

On November 9, 2023, through the process of this investigation, a semi-tractor trailer was intercepted coming from California to Ohio. Israel Garcia, the semi driver, was arrested after 15 kilos of cocaine were discovered in the cab of the semi. Mr. Garcia recounted delivering 17 kilos being delivered to Jovany Avila at the direction of Ema Loza.

On January 10, 2024, Ema Loza was arrested by the Columbus Police following a traffic stop. A felony amount of narcotics were discovered on Ms. Loza's person.

On January 25, 2024, Narcotics Detectives with the Columbus Police, Organized Crime Bureau conducted a search warrant at 85 Dering Ave. Nearly 2 kilos of drugs were seized along with additional evidence of an operational Drug Trafficking Organization (DTO).

Detectives identified the DTO members to be; Ema Loza, Jovany Avila, Jose Huerta, and Lezly Avila.
