Incident Summary: On July 20, 2024, at approximately 10:36 AM, Columbus Police Patrol officers were dispatched to a residence in the 1700 block of Genessee Avenue on a shooting. Officers arrived at the scene and found a victim, later identified as Mr. Tahvon Ford, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound inside the residence. CFD Medic 16 personnel arrived and pronounced the victim deceased at 10:46 AM. Next of kin has been notified.

Mr. Ford's girlfriend, Ms. Shirdenna Featherstone, was taken into custody at scene and charged with one count of Reckless Homicide F-3.
