**Incident Summary:** On 7/21/24 at approximately 1:28 am, an adult pedestrian was crossing South Hamilton Road, walking west to east, in an area south of the Winchester Pike intersection. There was no crosswalk or other provisions for pedestrian crossing at that location. At the same time, a white Toyota Prius was traveling northbound on Hamilton Road, approaching the same location. The Prius struck the pedestrian who was transported to an area hospital with severe injuries. The involved vehicle and vehicle operator remained at the scene. The pedestrian remains listed in critical condition but is expected to survive.

The Accident Investigation Unit responded to the scene and initiated an investigation which is ongoing.
