On May 19, 2024, patrol officers were dispatched to the 300 block of Marshall Passage on the report of shots fired. Upon arrival, they found an individual suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. Officers provided aid to the victim until Columbus Fire Medic #2 arrived and took over care. Victim #1 was transported to a local hospital in critical condition. Despite receiving life-saving medical care, victim #1 was pronounced deceased at 6:10 a.m. This is an on-going investigation.
