The supsect in all three cases was described as Male/Black 18-25 years old. He wore all black including a black hooded sweatshirt with white writing on it that stated "YOU'LL FLOAT TOO" and a mask covering the bottom half of his face. In one case he had a camouflage jacket over the sweatshirt.
