Incident Summary: On Wednesday, October 30, 2024, at 12:03AM, Columbus Police Officers were called to the 1000 block of E. Weber Rd. on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found Me'Khi Keys, 16, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Medic 16 transported Keys to Riverside Hospital in critical condition, where he was pronounced deceased at 12:35AM. The initial investigation revealed Keys and another juvenile were walking eastbound together when they encountered two unidentified males walking in the opposite direction. There was a brief exchange between the groups, then one of the unidentified males produced a handgun and shot Keys. After the shooting the two males ran east bound for a short distance before turning and continuing to run south away from the scene. It is possible the males ran south down Howey Rd. as they fled. Anyone with cameras on, or near, the 1000 block of E. Weber Rd. or Howey Rd. south of E. Weber Rd. is asked to check for video of the incident.
