Incident Summary: *UPDATE October 3, 2024***** Based upon information obtained during this investigation, Homicide detectives filed warrants for murder against several suspects. On October 3, 2024, Mr. Sincere Langford and Mr. Terrell Felton were taken into custody without incident by Columbus Police SWAT personnel.

Mr. Kenrell Felton, Male/Black/19 YOA turned himself in at Columbus Police Headquarters on his Murder warrant also on October 3, 2024.

UPDATE September 22, 2024 On September 21st, 2024, despite all efforts by medical staff, the victim in this incident, identified as Mr. Rayshawn Rogers, was pronounced deceased. Next of kin have been notified.

On September 19, 2024, at approximately 9:26 PM, Columbus Police Patrol officers were dispatched to the 1100 block of E. 12th Avenue on report of a shooting. Officers arrived at scene and found a male victim suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Medic personnel transported the victim to a local hospital in critical condition. Due to the severity of the victim's injury, the Homicide Unit is investigating.
