

LIVINGSTON AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS - ALUM CREEK TRAIL TO JAMES ROAD

DESCRIPTION AND BENEFITS

This project consists of the improvements to Livingston Avenue from Alum Creek Trail to James Road with the City of Bexley. The project will provide infrastructure improvements designed to enhance pedestrian, bicyclist, and motorist safety by building shared use paths, replacing the traffic signals and street lighting, and installing planted medians.
