

POLARIS PARKWAY WIDENING - GEMINI PLACE TO SOUTH OLDE STREET ROAD

DESCRIPTION AND BENEFITS

This project consists of widening Polaris Parkway to add a right turn lane from Gemini Place to approximately 1,004 feet south of South Old State Road. At the intersection of Polaris Parkway and Antares Avenue, a span wire signal is to be installed. The east leg of Antares Avenue shall be widened to provide a westbound right turn lane. The project includes installation of sidewalk along the east side of Polaris Parkway from Gemini Place to South Old State Road and the east leg of Antares Avenue where impacted by the widening.
