FRONT STREET AND MARCONI BOULEVARD IMPROVEMENTS

DESCRIPTION AND BENEFITS

This project consists of converting Front Street from Broad Street to Hickory Street and Marconi Boulevard from Broad Street to Spring Street to two-way operation. Signals were upgraded within the project limits to decorative downtown standard. Project includes installation of new granite curb, buff wash sidewalk, street and pedestrian lighting, enhanced pedestrian crossings and landscaping beds.

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT/ADDITIONAL RESOURCES

Construction Update: Work has progressed very well and is set to complete in the late portions of the 2024 season. Traffic will be converted as the last phase of the work. Intersection at Hickory has been modified to accommodate the two way conversion and a traffic pattern change will occur in the late summer. Reconstruction of the ADA ramps continue to be conducted corner-by-corner to maintain pedestrian traffic.
