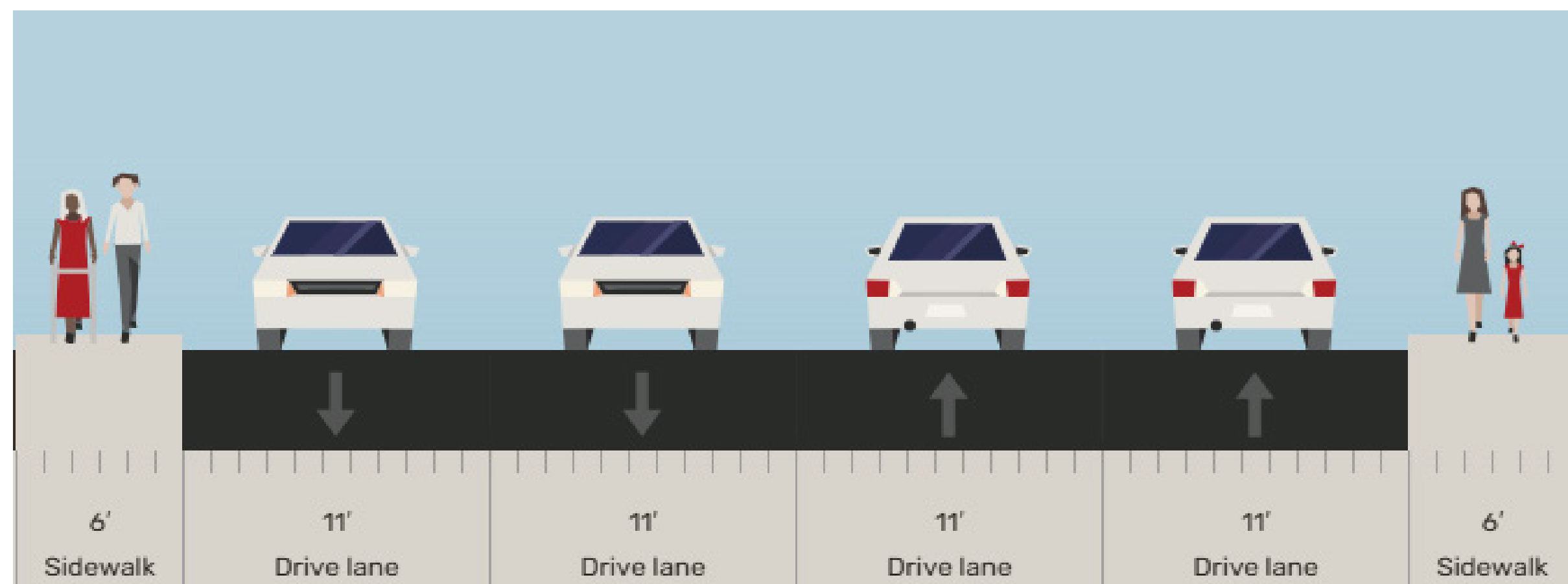


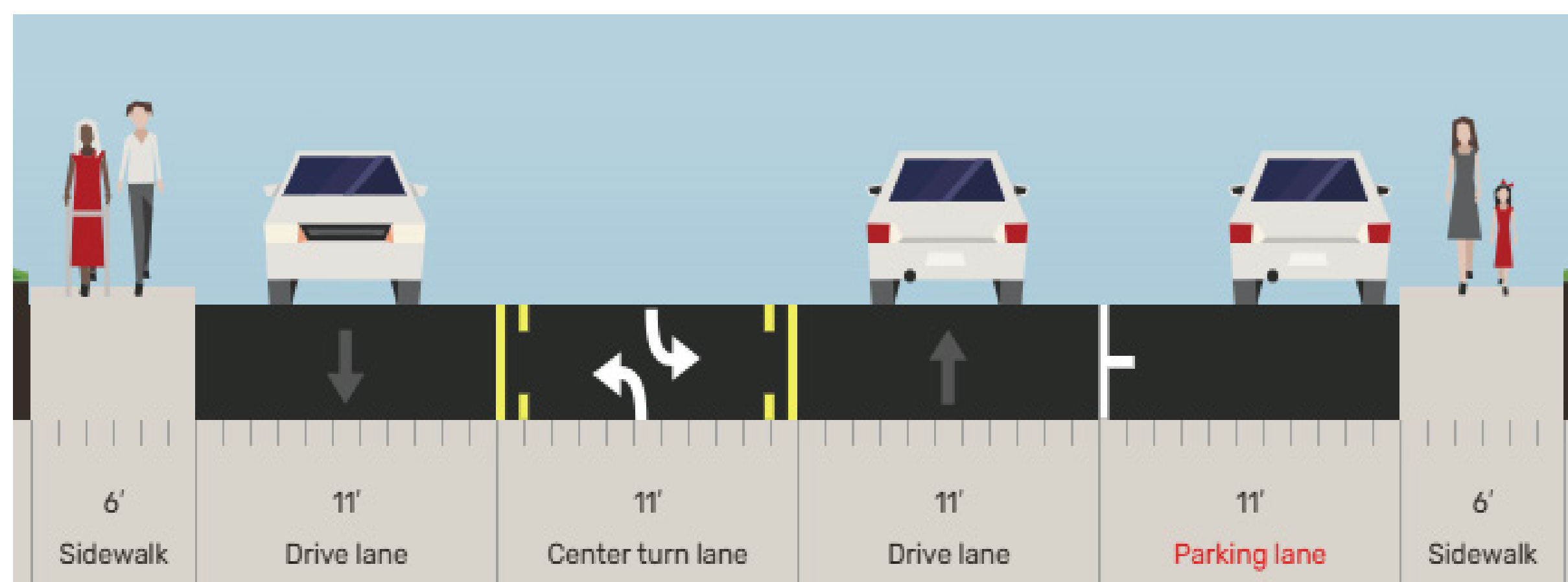
PURPOSE

The 5th Avenue Safety Improvement Project is aimed at reducing speeding, crashes, and red light running which currently creates an unsafe condition for this pedestrian oriented route. The proposed improvements will narrow the road from its current 4-lanes to one travel lane in each direction with a center turn lane. 5th Avenue is on the Vision Zero High-Injury Network and these improvements will improve safety in the near future.

PROJECT DETAILS

- Converting a 4-lane roadway to 3-lanes, one in each direction with a center turn lane
- Removing left-turn restriction on High Street
- Adding a curb extension on 4th Street to slow turns
- Project funded with Ohio Department of Transportation Safety Funds

PARKING IMPACT

- Peak-restricted on-Street parking on the north side of 5th Avenue is being removed
- On-Street parking on the south side of 5th Avenue is now permanent instead of peak-restricted. This will be free 3-hour parking from 8am to 12am.



TIMELINE

- Construction tentatively scheduled from August to October 2025
