


ANNUAL CITYWIDE TOP 25 PRIORITY INTERSECTIONS FOR SAFETY ANALYSIS

 As part of our Vision Zero 2023-2028 strategy to **USE DATA TO INFORM SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS**, we have established an annual citywide top 25 priority intersections for safety analysis list.

As stated in the action plan, this data-informed list –

- Identifies and sets specific safety project priorities for corridors
- Identifies corridor-wide safety issues based on the number of these intersections within a corridor
- Is paired with a list of intersections that have been improved.

HOW WAS THE PRIORITY INTERSECTIONS LIST DEVELOPED?

For every intersection in Columbus, the total number of crashes within 250 feet of the intersection over a three-year period and the crash rate were both calculated.

The severity of crashes at an intersection was calculated by assigning more weight to severe crashes. The most weight was assigned to fatal and serious injury crashes – Vision Zero Columbus is focused on ending these crashes – followed by minor injury and possible injury crashes. Property damage-only crashes received the least weight.

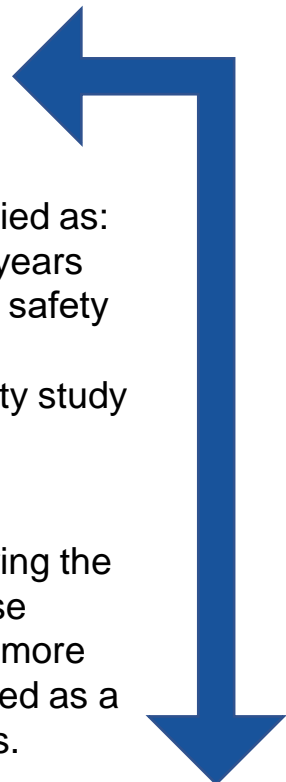
STUDY STATUS

The Study Status for each identified priority intersection is classified as:

- ‘Studied’ if a safety study was completed within the past five years
- ‘Study in Progress’ if the intersection is being studied now for safety improvements (as of October 2024), or
- ‘Future Study’ if funding is being identified to complete a safety study of the intersection.

SAFETY PROJECT STATUS

The Safety Project Status supplements the Study Status by sharing the progress made in addressing corridor-wide safety issues for these priority intersections. The priority intersections that were studied more than five years ago – and had study recommendations constructed as a result – are under study again for additional safety improvements.
