WHAT:

Councilmember [Emmanuel V. Remy](#), Chair of the Public Safety Committee, and Councilmember Rob Dorans, Chair of the Building & Zoning Policy Committee, will host a public hearing to learn more about proposed Electric Vehicle (EV) Ready Parking legislation coming before Columbus City Council in June 2022. The legislation will require that newly built parking lots and garages have a minimum number of EV charging stations installed upon completion of construction and have the electrical infrastructure to add more charging stations easily and affordably in the future.

The proposed EV Ready Parking legislation reflects the input and feedback provided by a diverse set of stakeholders, community groups, and residents through a year-long co-creation process.
